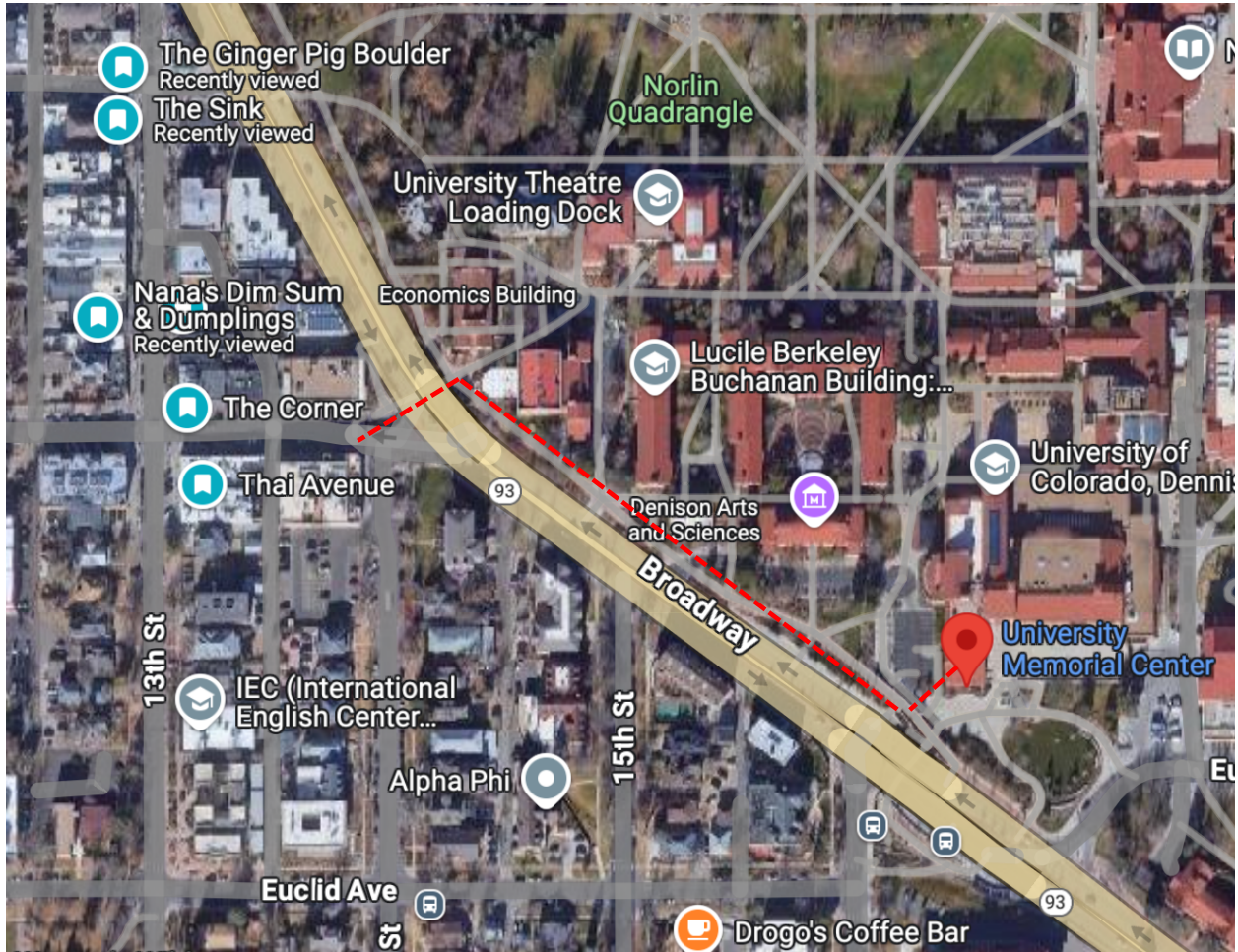


## IOMW 2025 Dining Recommendations

Dashed red line represents walking path from UMC to College Avenue on “the Hill.” There is an underpath that takes you beneath Broadway. Best not to try to cross Broadway on foot! There is also an underpath closer to the UMC that takes you to Euclid Ave. That’s another option for getting to the Hill.

#### **Thai Avenue**

Really good Thai food! It is inside a food court on your left as you walk along College Ave heading west. In this food court you will also find Japanese and Korean food.

Good sandwiches and salads. Lots of healthy options.
